

## NWISL Policy 114

### SEVERE WEATHER POLICY

In NWISL, there are parks that have Early Lightning Prediction and Warning Systems. WE MUST ABIDE BY THESE SYSTEMS. If a siren or horn goes off, **THE FIELD MUST BE CLEARED AT ONCE!** Until an all clear siren or horn is sounded, the game may not continue. THIS IS A BY LAW. If after 30 minutes the all clear has not sounded, then the game is ended.

If you have finished the 1<sup>st</sup> half, **THE GAME IS FINAL.**

If you have not finished the 1<sup>st</sup> half, the game will be rescheduled by the club reps.

In parks that do not have Early Lightning Prediction and Warning Systems, it is the responsibility of the referee to call the game. This means that if any lightning is sighted (at all) **THE FIELD MUST BE CLEARED AT ONCE!** (Coaches, please respect the Referees call.)

If after 30 minutes, the weather conditions do not change, the game is ended.

If you have finished the 1<sup>st</sup> half, **THE GAME IS FINAL.**

If you have not finished the 1<sup>st</sup> half, the game will be rescheduled by the club reps.

COACHES DO NOT RESCHEDULE GAMES.

NEXT SCHEDULED GAME WILL BE DETERMINED AT GAME TIME ON WEATHER CONDITIONS.

ONLY CLUB REPS CAN CLOSE A FIELD FOR THE DAY DUE TO THE WEATHER.
